- ❖ We would require full payment and final chargeable numbers 3 weeks before the event. If we do not receive full payment we have the right to cancel the event or cancel the booking.
- ❖ Full payment will be retained as a cancellation fee if the event is not cancelled 3 weeks before the event. A full refund is available if cancellation is made 3 weeks before the event.
