Access Statement for Argyll Hotel Glasgow



Introduction

Situated in the historic city of Glasgow the Small hotel is the perfect place to stay whether you are visiting for business or leisure. Located in the city we are a 15 minute walk, or a 5 minute bus ride from the main shops and attractions. The Small hotel is situated in the west end of the city next the famous Kelvingrove art gallery and museum.

We offer 38 en-suite tastefully decorated tartan themed bedrooms. The hotel is occupied over 4 level's which are accessible by lift. Rooms on the ground floor are all with en-suite walk in showers. For breakfast, where possible, we use locally sourced ingredients and cater for varying dietary requirements.

Pre-Arrival

- For full details and maps of how to reach us please see the directions section of our website. Alternatively, you can plan your journey by car or public transport using www.transportdirect.info; simply enter your postcode and ours, which is G37tq to get directions.
- The nearest railway station is SECC, which is 0.5 miles away (a 10-15 minute walk). The main railway station is Central station 10-15 taxi ride. Taxis are available at the station. If you require an accessible taxi this can be booked in advance, see contact information for details.
- The nearest bus stop is 30yds from the B&B – ask the driver for the stop on Sauchiehall street next to the Argyll Hotel. There is shelter and seating. All buses can accommodate one wheelchair

- The payment on the street leading to the hotel is paved
- The access statement is available in a larger print on request.

Car Parking and Arrival

- There are five parking spaces available at the back of the hotel by turning left at Grey Street and then left on to Derby terrace lane.
- It's advisable for guests to leave luggage in through the front door before parking the car as there is no back access.
- The driveway has a gravel path leading to the car park. There is no access from the back door and the guests need to walk round. This is well lit at night by a motion sensor light.
- On street parking is available, this can be busy during the day from 8am, but spaces are usually available in side streets.
- If the car park is full then we have parking vouchers for on street parking which is £4.00 for the whole day or £2.00 for half day depending on what time you arrive. The parking restriction is between 8am till 6pm Mon- Fri and weekends is free. Parking is free after 6pm.
- There are 5 steps to the front door with wrought iron handrails on both sides.
- The front door is 750mm/29.5ins wide.?
- Assistance can be given with luggage.

Welcome Area

- Guests are welcomed in the hallway, which is level throughout, where they are asked to register.
- Seating is available with 2 upright chesterfield chairs, both with arms and 2-seater chesterfield sofa.
- The flooring is tartan carpet with 1 large rug at entrance.
- The area is evenly and well lit with overhead lighting and wall lights.
- A magnifying glass, pen and pad of paper are available on request.
- Guests are shown the guest lounge, dining room and their bedroom.

Bedrooms

- There is 1 bedroom with twin beds, on the ground floor, with step free level access from the front door. On the first floor there is 6 rooms with a mixture of single double and twin rooms.
- The door to the ground floor bedroom is 800mm/31.5ins wide, the other 2 are 750mm/29.5ins wide.
- Furniture can be easily removed or rearranged in ground floor rooms only
- The height of all of the beds from the top of the mattress to the floor is 450mm/17.7ins.

Bathrooms, Shower-rooms & Toilets (Ensuite or Shared)

- All rooms have en-suite bathrooms. The ground floor bedroom en-suite bathroom offers walk in showers.
- Door opening to the bathroom varies from room to room.
- A level entry, step free shower.
- The toilet height is 400mm/15.7ins.
- Dual flush toilets with soft close seats.
- The wash basin height is 800mm/31.5ins.
- Lever taps on the washbasin and bath.
- Grab rails, available on request.
- Shower mats available on request
- A grab rail by the bath.
- Sensor bathroom mirrors with a saver socket
- Well lit with overhead lights

Public Areas - Halls, Stairs, Landings, Corridors

- All public areas, halls, stairs, landing, are well lit using a combination of ceiling and wall lights.
- There is short pile carpet on the stairs, hall and landing.
- There is a continuous flight of thirteen steps to the first floor with a handrail on one side.

Public Areas - Lounge

- The guest lounge/ Bar area is situated in the basement floor accessible by lift from first floor with step free/level entry from the front door and stairs.
- The door opening to the dining room in the basement (accessible by lift from ground floor) is 750mm/29.5ins wide.
- The bar area room has a mixture of seating with stools and soft chairs as well as some high chairs with and without arms, together with a high bar table.
- Lighting is natural daylight and light levels are controlled

Public Toilet

- There are public toilets located beside the bar.
- Entrance is via front door then the lift or the stairs.
- There are 2 toilets one for ladies and one for men's.
- The men's toilets has 2 cubicles and 2 urinal with 2 sinks and a hand dryer.
- There is one big step leading to the men's toilet which is highlighted.
- The ladies toilet has 2 cubicles and 2 sinks with a hand dryer.
- There is a big step leading to the ladies toilet which is highlighted
- The toilet door slides with a clear opening width of 700mm.
- The toilet height is 400mm/15.7ins.
- The toilet is well lit with halogen overhead lights.

Dining Room

- The dining room is situated on the basement floor with a lift entry from the front door and stairs.
- The door opening to the dining room is 750mm/29.5ins wide and it is level throughout.
- Lighting is natural daylight and light levels are controlled by dimmer switches, with overhead and wall lighting used.
- The flooring is tartan carpet.
- We are able to cater for varying dietary requirements. Please advise us when making a booking

Additional Information

- The owner has attended the 'Welcome All' training course.
- We have a set of evacuation procedures – should you require it someone will come to your room and assist you with evacuation.
- We welcome trained assistance dogs. A water bowl is available just outside the front door for assistance.
- We have tried to ensure each doorframe contrasts in colour with the surrounding wall.

Future Plans

- We are planning a review of our website later this year to make it more accessible, your comments are welcome to assist us with this project.
- We will be joining the National Accessible Scheme to gain a rating for those people with limited mobility and hearing and visual impairments.
- We have asked the local access group to visit our property and we will endeavour to make any suggested accessibility improvements where possible
